

## Internet Explorer Mode in Microsoft Edge

Open your Microsoft Edge Browser and Click on the "Settings and More" button on the right side of your browser window. Select Settings from the Menu.



From the Settings Menu, select **Default Browser**. Under **Internet Explorer Compatibility**, select **Add** next to the **Internet Explorer mode pages**. A box will appear to enter a URL. Enter the URL for Remote Deposit 4.1: <u>https://remotedeposit.sandyspringbank.com/WDDL/login.aspx</u>. Then click the **Add** button.

You also have the option to avoid this re-occurring enablement. In order to do this, we suggest that the change in IE Mode in Edge be done at the Enterprise level. Whomever handles the workstation management/Group Policy should set up the URL list. This is typically done by your IT team. When the Enterprise level adds a URL to their Enterprise IE Mode list, it should load in IE Mode on all workstations on the network and this list should be permanent (until changed by the Enterprise Group Policy).
